

## Department of Theatre and Dance

The University of South Alabama Department of Theatre and Dance invites applications for a full-time (twelve-month), tenure-track position as Chair of the Department of Theatre and Dance at the rank of Associate or Full Professor, starting August 15, 2025.

**Qualifications:** An earned terminal degree (MFA and/or PhD) in theatre or a related field is required for a tenure-track appointment. Candidates will be expected to demonstrate a record of creative or scholarly achievement commensurate with a faculty appointment at the rank of a tenured Associate Professor or Professor, including a body of work that represents a significant contribution to the field and demonstrated excellence in post-secondary teaching. The candidate will exhibit commitment to both liberal arts education and professional theatre training, and the skills to articulate a clear vision of how the two can complement and enhance each other in a research university. Successful candidates will possess leadership, administrative, and supervisory experience in strategic and financial planning, curricular innovation, and recruitment and retention of faculty, staff, and students. Specialization in Technical Theatre is preferred. The successful candidate will also show evidence of a commitment to community engagement, with the ability to lead effective change in diverse groups.

**Responsibilities:** The successful candidate will teach courses dependent on their area of expertise, whether in acting/directing or technical theatre (specifically scene and lighting design), and other courses as needed.

The Chair serves as the artistic director for the Department, collaborating with department faculty to set the department's mission and goals for research, teaching, artistry, and service. The Chair must also recruit and support a diverse faculty, staff, and student body; coordinate the department's season planning process; build relationships with area theatre, dance, and arts organizations; administer the department's budget; plan strategic advances and target growth in the department's programs.

Additional responsibilities include academic advising and mentoring theatre students, as well as the placement of interns. Contribution to the field through active scholarly and/or related creative activities is encouraged. Service on university committees and active participation in respected state, regional, and national organizations is also expected.
